Our year 6 children were lucky enough to be able to visit Warning Zone in Leicester last week. This is a brilliant place where the children learn and experience different events that may happen in real life.

For the other half of the day, the emphasis was on personal safety, looking at arson, vandalism, drugs and alcohol. The whole experience presented plain honest facts in a memorable and understandable way in order to encourage responsible behaviour and make the right choices.
