Scooters and Bikes In School

Whilst we are happy for children to ride scooters and bikes to school under parents supervision and can accommodate them being kept in our bike shelter during the school day, children **are not to ride them into or whilst in the school grounds. This rule applies to the paths, ramps and playgrounds too!** Bikes and scooters must be walked into and out of school.

Also as a matter of safety, children should not climb over the railings on the ramp, it is very dangerous and is an accident waiting to happen.
