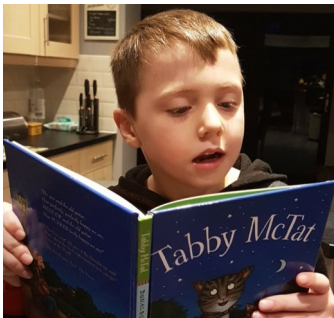
Selfie Challenge

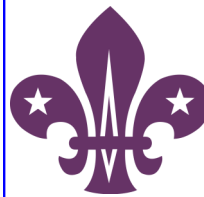
