School Uniform

We encourage children to look smart and feel part of our school by wearing our uniform, so before you purchase uniform for the next school year we would like to remind you of our uniform policy.

Our uniform is royal blue and grey (not black). Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers with a light blue or white polo shirt and a school sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan. Shoes should be black, suitable for school (not trainers) and worn with black, grey or white tights or socks. Checked summer dresses may be worn. PE kits should be a t-shirt (house colour), black shorts with black or white plimsolls for indoor use and trainers for use outdoors.

Jewellery is not allowed with the exception of a watch and stud earrings that the child must be able to take out or cover themselves for swimming and PE.

If you would like to order any uniform for next term please call into the office for an order form or download one from our website as soon as possible as it takes a number of weeks to process and manufacture orders.
