

In 2013/14 Greystoke Primary School received funding of £38,481 this is allocated to pupils who receive Free school Meals, those who have had FSM in the past 6 years, children in care, pupils who have parents in the Armed Forces.

We are currently spending the funds on the following items:

- Breakfast club
- Staff to support individuals
- Staff to support group work
- Numeracy Catch Up programme and training
- Trip support
- Uniform support

Breakfast Club is funded for two days per week and gives emotional literacy support, homework support and breakfast to those children who attend.

Group and individual support enables children to be supported with areas of weakness, ie., spelling, handwriting, numeracy , reading and writing. This work is planned by a teacher and some is supported by teaching assistants.

Numeracy Catch Up is a fully supported programme which some staff have been trained to use and supports the children through a regular short session to fill any gaps that children have in their maths.

Trip support is given to children for both day and residential trips

In special circumstances uniform can be supplied for children receiving Pupil Premium support
