Curriculum Overview

### Reading

This term, we will work on retaining and reading set 1 & set 2 sounds. We will be encouraging children to apply their phonics knowledge when reading words, captions and sentences containing the sounds they have learnt so far.

We will continue to read once week in school and change books regularly.

Phonics learning resources of what has been taught will be sent home weekly on TEAMS and handwriting sheets will be handed out.

## Phonics and writing

Children will continue to write four times a week in whole class sessions. They will use and apply what they have learnt in phonics to write words.

They will be writing a series of short sentences that follow on from the previous one.

They will use known letter-sound correspondences.

Children will be expected to re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense.

They will spell phonically regular words with more than one syllable (e.g. carpet, doormat etc.)

Through weekly handwriting sessions, children will develop the foundations of a handwriting style which is fast, accurate and efficient.

#### Maths

In Maths we will learning about 3d shapes and their properties.

We will be looking at numbers to 20 and beyond by building numbers and counting patterns.

We will be adding more and taking away.

We will be working on skills involving spatial reasoning, composing, and decomposing.

## Expressive Arts and Design

This term the children will be creating art linked to our topic books.

We will be designing a paper plate version of Zog.

We will be making crown decorations and magic wands.

We will be using various drawing skills to produce royal family portraits.

We will attempt to construct our own castles.

We will paint King Charles and write party invitations for our Royal Ball.
