Rainforests!

Topic focus: Science and DT

We will be learning about where in the world rainforests can be found and what lives there. We will be understanding plant and animal life cycles, food chains and learning about why animals live in their habitats. We will discover how different levels of the rainforest can hide different animal and describe what they need to survive. We will then be applying this knowledge to build moving models of the rainforest as our final outcome.

Grammar and Spelling

We are continuing to learn about different spelling patterns and rules. This will inform our weekly spelling tests and we will practice spelling common exceptions words too.

English

'Fantastic Mr Fox'

We will be unpicking and describing characters from the story, using role play and oracy skills to understand their feelings. We will be writing instructions about how to catch a fox using adverbs and imperative verbs. Finally, we will be writing a diary in role as Mr Fox to retell the events of the story.

Our grammar focuses are adverbs, conjunctions, past tense verbs, apostrophes for possessions and similes. We will also be linking some of our writing to our work on Rainforests, producing fact sheets on different animals.
