'The Iron Man' and 'An Explanation text of the Water Cycle'.

We will explore, reading and unpicking our new text, 'The Iron Man' whilst focusing on specific grammar skills: Fronted Adverbials, descriptive devices (similes and personification), commas in a list and compound sentences. These will help us to innovate our model text creating our own version of the Iron Man. Learning these features will allow us to firstly write a narrative and then an explanation text related to our topic. This will explain our understanding of the Water Cycle.

Integrated Curriculum – World of Water.

Children will be learning all about Water; how it was used in the past, how we can take care of it and what we can do in the future to make sure more people have access to clean water. Children will be learning about states of matter, living things and electricity as part of our science curriculum. Within this unit, we will learn all about the Water Cycle and use this knowledge to understand how this can impact people all round the globe. We will also be exploring the United Kingdom, what it is made up of and key features with a focus on rivers. We will be having visits from Sevent Trent who will deepen our understanding of these areas and the importance of keeping water clean.
