History - Ancient Egypt

In our history unit this term, children will be learning all about Ancient Egypt. Children will be able to chronologically plot key events, consider where the Egyptians fit in history, alongside known time periods. Children will be able to understand the importance of the River Nile and major achievements of the Egyptians, such as hieroglyphics.

Geography

Our unit of work for the Autumn term is called 'Planet Earth'. We will use a range of different maps (including GPS and digital mapping) to locate capital cities and landmarks across the globe. We will learn about lines of latitude and longitude as well as understand and locate different biomes. By the end of the unit, we will be able to compare different biomes.

Science

During this term, children will be learning about the topics: Living things and their habitats and Earth and Space. Firstly, we will be learning about life cycles of different animal groups and comparing these. We will explore gestational periods and how they differ. Children will learn and research how climate change and deforestation is impacting these life cycles. Children will also investigate famous naturalist. Within our Earth and Space unit, children will learn about the solar system, Earth's movements, atmosphere and understand the heliocentric model.
