

## Integrated Curriculum

Topic focus: Geography, Art and Music

We will be using our geography knowledge to compare where we live with New Delhi. We will be learning about how life, homes, jobs and climate is different and working with the ASHA charity to understand the global themes of rights to education and shelter.

We will be listening and creating music from this region and learning traditional dance too. This will end with a shared exhibition of learning to share our knowledge with all of you!

We will be using drama and a range of oracy strategies to understand and retell the story to begin. We will then unpick the text, understand the characters, and write a twisted version of the story. Our final outcome will then be creating, planning and writing our very own adventure story.

Our grammar focuses will be around coordinating and subordinating conjunctions, using adverbs to open sentences (linking to commas) and using past and present tense correctly throughout our work.
