

## Integrated Curriculum

It's All Greek to Me!

Topic focus: Geography and History

In Geography, we will be learning to identify and recognise countries in Europe, including Greece. We will be using atlases, maps and Google Earth to help us to locate countries and will learn skills of map reading and how to use grid references.

In History, we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks, their achievements and the contributions that they have made. We will also use timelines to help us to think about events in the past as well as sources such as artefacts which give us clues about history.

Explore a simple clay technique such as making slab pieces, and decorate them with patterns based upon observational drawing skills.

## English

We will be reading *One Plastic Bag*, by Miranda Paul.

We will be using the text to write a non-chronological report about Gambia where our new text set, and a descriptive narrative.

To do this, we will be learning about word classes and families, how to identify and use prefixes, maintain a consistent tense in our writing and think carefully about powerful word choices.
